are all sinners. "There is no righteous

man, not even one." (Romans 3:10)

"For all have sinned and come short

of the glory of God." (Romans 3:23)

ignored Him.

You may have heard that Jesus

said "I am the way, and the truth, and

the life, no man comes to the father

except by me." (John 14:6) but you

have a feeling that there might be

another way. Maybe you have been

One night, Nicodemus, an im-

portant Jewish leader, visited Jesus.

Nicodemus was probably as religious

as a man can get, but Jesus told him,

"If any man is not begotten [born] from

above, he cannot see the kingdom of

God." (John 3:3) Later, Jesus repeated

this truth to Nicodemus, "You must

be begotten from above." (John 3:7)

Nicodemus asked the same question

that is probably in your mind right

now, "How can a person be begotten

[born] from above?"

The Bible tells us what Jesus said: "Just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness so must the Son of Man [Jesus Christ] be lifted up, so that every man who believes in him would not perish, but may have eternal life. For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten Son [Jesus Christ], so that every man who believes in him would not perish, but have eternal life. For God sent the Son into the world not that he might condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him. He who believes in him is not condemned. He who does not believe has been condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God." (John 3:14-18)
