

Another great systemic way of sharing the message of salvation found only in Jesus Christ is the Romans road. It is time proved and has lead multitudes to salvation in Jesus Christ.

The Romans Road

Here is a list of verses called the "Roman Road." The advantage to these seven verses is that they are all in the book of Romans. Sometimes this is an advantage when you don't want to flip through a lot of pages. You can use it with other scriptures like **John 3:16** or other scriptures you are familiar with.

1. **Romans 3:10**, "As it is written, 'There is none righteous, not even one...'"
2. **Romans 3:23**, "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."
3. **Romans 5:12**, "Therefore, just as through one man sin entered into the world, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men, because all sinned."
4. **Romans 6:23**, "For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."
5. **Romans 5:8**, "But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."
6. **Romans 10:9-10**, "if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you shall be saved; for with the heart man believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation."
7. **Romans 10:13**, "For whoever will call upon the name of the Lord will be saved."
8. Jesus said, Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me. **Revelation 3:20**

Ask Is Jesus knocking on your heart's door? Tell them they need to pray asking Him to come in to your heart believing He will by faith (not feelings).

Get them to open the Bible to the Gospel of John and read what God says about Jesus, about them, and about being born again. God will help them. He loves them.

I recommend you put the Roman Road in your Bible. Go to Romans 3:10 underline it and write Romans 3:23 next to it. Then go to Romans 3:28, underline it and write Romans 5:12 next to it, and so on. That way all you need to do is memorise where you start: Romans 3:10.

Receive, through faith in Jesus Christ, his free gift of salvation.
