The reality is that you do not have to be envious of other Christians or other revivals because Father God has a portion just for you that no one can touch because it has your name on it, a blessing that has your Churches name on it! It was born out of prayer and we would encourage all individual Christians throughout the UK to start this plan. There are lots of evangelistic ideas, free resources, tracts and links that will help you available on the website.

We have included ways to reach your communities with a selection of outreach ideas. We also have a whole section dedicated to reaching people from other religions with appropriate tracts, testimonies and links. Please make use of this section as it's so important to reach lost seekers of God.

Volunteer Evangelists

Our vision is for the UK Christian Church, individual Christians and also the formation of a national network of evangelists who feel called to build the Churches throughout the United Kingdom.
