Sharing the Christian message of salvation with people who we see on a day to day basis is vital. We cannot ignore our responsibility to make sure they understand what salvation is, how they can receive it and the consequences of both acceptance or rejection of the gospel message. The reality is that 99% of Christians do not share their faith at Work, School, College or University. My question is **WHY?**

Even active Christians who evangelize do not share the message of salvation at Work/School/College or University for a number of good reasons.

**The reason most Christians find it so difficult to share is because they don't now how to start a conversation.**

By the time they have planned a strategy, got a main scripture and are still deciding what they will do if in the unlikely event their colleague at work/S/C/U accepts salvation. They become that stressed out that they jump on the poor non Christian with a muddled message that's embarrassing to them and also to their colleague. **We are constantly stressing ourselves out looking for the next person at work to try and reach with the salvation message.**

**Reasons why Christians have given up on the idea of sharing at Work/S/C/U:**

Christians do not share their faith at work because they do not know how to do it.

One of the major problems Christians face is starting conversations that do not make them look like religious fanatics.

## A Sober Thought

Oswald J. Smith said:

Oh my friends, we are loaded down with countless church activities, while the real work of the Church, that of evangelising and winning the lost, is almost entirely neglected. We have polished the engines of worship, prayer, and praise and neglected the sober task given to us by God. A firefighter who ignores his responsibilities and allows people to perish in flames is not a firefighter; he is an impostor. Christians feel isolated at Work/S/C/U when they share the message of salvation with colleagues.

The fear that people they are with everyday will become defensive and reject them.

Fear of making colleagues feel upset or uncomfortable.

**We really have to stop this stressful approach to evangelism at Work S/C/U and look to Jesus Christ for wisdom.**

**What did Jesus say?**

**And Jesus said unto them, Come ye after me, and I will make you to become fishers of men (show you how to fish for people). Mark 1:17 (KJV)**

**We do the fishing, they ask the questions and God does the saving.**

**Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light. Matthew 11:29-30 (KJV)**

**Most Christians do not understand evangelism (fishing) they do not know how to do it, that's okay its easy to learn.**

We have to learn to casually place little comments about the things God is doing in our lives (or the lives of Christians we know) in our day to day conversations. If someone at work/S/C/U is sick you can mention you were healed or tell them about a healing at Church. These comments act as bait and cause spiritual hunger and thirst in peoples lives which lead them to ask us questions. We then answer the questions, win their trust and gradually lead them into a relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ.

We have to be patient with the non Christians that we are fishing for, never preach at them or come across as dogmatic. Allow them to ask questions when they are ready. **We can turn people off or confuse them by saying too much too soon and using Biblical words they do not understand (little by little put out your bait in conversation, you would not put fifty worms onto one hook).** Speak briefly and leave them to make the next move. Non Christians need time to think about the things we tell them and time for the Holy Spirit to work on their hearts.

**Its time to put down that awful burden of stress you are carrying about sharing the message of salvation at Work/S/C/U.**

Start to share little interesting events that the Lord has done in your Christian life, let them nibble at the bait and come back for more.

Eventually you will have an opportunity to give a good tract, book, CD or DVD about others who have found salvation in Jesus Christ. As you win their trust you maybe able to share the message of salvation or invite them to a Church Service. **Remember it was not a mistake that Jesus called fishermen to become the first Church builders.**
