A Sober Thought

Oswald J. Smith said:

Oh my friends, we are loaded down with countless church activities, while the real work of the Church, that of evangelising and winning the lost, is almost entirely neglected.

We have polished the engines of worship, prayer, and praise and neglected the sober task given to us by God. A firefighter who ignores his responsibilities and allows people to perish in flames is not a firefighter; he is an impostor. How can we ignore our responsibility and allow the world to walk blindly into the fires of hell? If God's love dwells in us, we must warn them.



Romans 10;14 How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher?

This is the month of maximum evangelistic opportunity where family members, friends and communities around our Churches are most open and can be most impacted by the message of salvation found only in Jesus Christ. You can talk freely about Jesus in December its His birth month according to the world. So His powerful name which gets such strong reactions from the lost suddenly becomes more accepted in December and thus you are able to witness more effectively. Christmas gives you the perfect conversation starter to tell your family, friends and community about this miracle baby, why he came and what He did for them to save them.

December is the month that Jesus is often on the minds of non Christians because of nativity plays and religious programs on Television or the annual yearly visit to a Church. They are easy to talk to about Jesus and the salvation He offers them. Remember December is a time of giving gifts so let some of your gifts be Christian DVD's Books and tracts to those in your family and amongst your friends and communities. It's also a very lonely month for those who live alone maybe a family member, friend or older person in the community, we need to do our best individually and as a Church to reach the lonely. Provide a meal and some warm fellowship and hopefully the gospel. Try as a church to reach the elderly people in the community and make sure they are saved. Jesus loves them so much and wants them with Him on earth and in heaven but they need to hear the truth so they can accept prayer and salvation.

December is a month when you can send a card and letter to everyone you know explaining how Jesus has changed your life, remember to include a tract or the prayer of salvation. This is a way of reaching a lot of non Christian people who you know. It's the month your Church should be most active (**always have a Christmas day service**). Please organize a family outreach as a Church, invite all your family and friends to a themed event (maybe a children's nativity play or music) followed this with an interesting testimony, then the minister/evangelist should giving an interesting message that includes how to be saved followed by a prayer for salvation. The event should be followed by a Church organized candle lite meal (in the Church if possible). This and the warm fellowship will have a real impact on visitors. Everyone who attends should be invited to a follow on event in the New Year.

Remember do not waste December it's our platform to share this wonderful life and love that Christ has graciously gifted into our lives and Churches.

Visit People, family and friends, extended family you have lost touch with, tell them about your faith and give them a gift of a Christian DVD, book or tract that will help them understand salvation in Jesus Christ.

December is our month and it provides us with a great opportunity to reach those around us who we love with this wonderful message of salvation given to us by our Saviour Jesus Christ.

The Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit, grace be with you all as you obey and witness for Him.
